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


The Problem- Prevalence of MSK Conditions

 MSK conditions are described as conditions affecting the bones, joints, muscles and spine



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
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Approximately **32.2 million** prescriptions (-4.0% since 2016) were dispensed for MSK and joint diseases in England in 2017, costing approximately **£195.3 million** (-5.1% since 2016).⁷³

Around 8.75 million people aged 45 years and over (33%) in the UK have sought treatment for osteoarthritis.1

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

Osteoarthritis of the knee

OA is a condition in which the joints of the body become damaged and stop moving freely.

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
- It is a combination of the breakdown of the joint and body's attempted repair processes
- ► Knee is the most common site in the body for OA



GENICULAR ARTERY EMBOLIZATION

A small catheter is inserted.

Tiny particles are injected to limit blood flow to areas of inflammation in the knee joint.

By limiting blood flow to the areas of inflammation in the knee pain is decreased.

GAE: NICE Guidelines

Evidence on the safety of genicular artery embolisation for pain from knee osteoarthritis shows no major safety concerns in the short term

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- Evidence on its efficacy and long-term safety is inadequate in quality and quantity
- Therefore, this procedure should only be used in the context of research.

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


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
