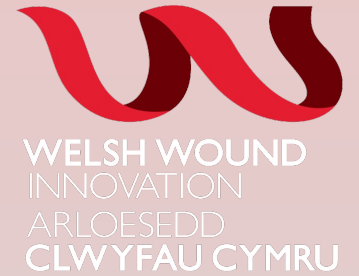
This course needs to be compulsory to all health organisations!!!

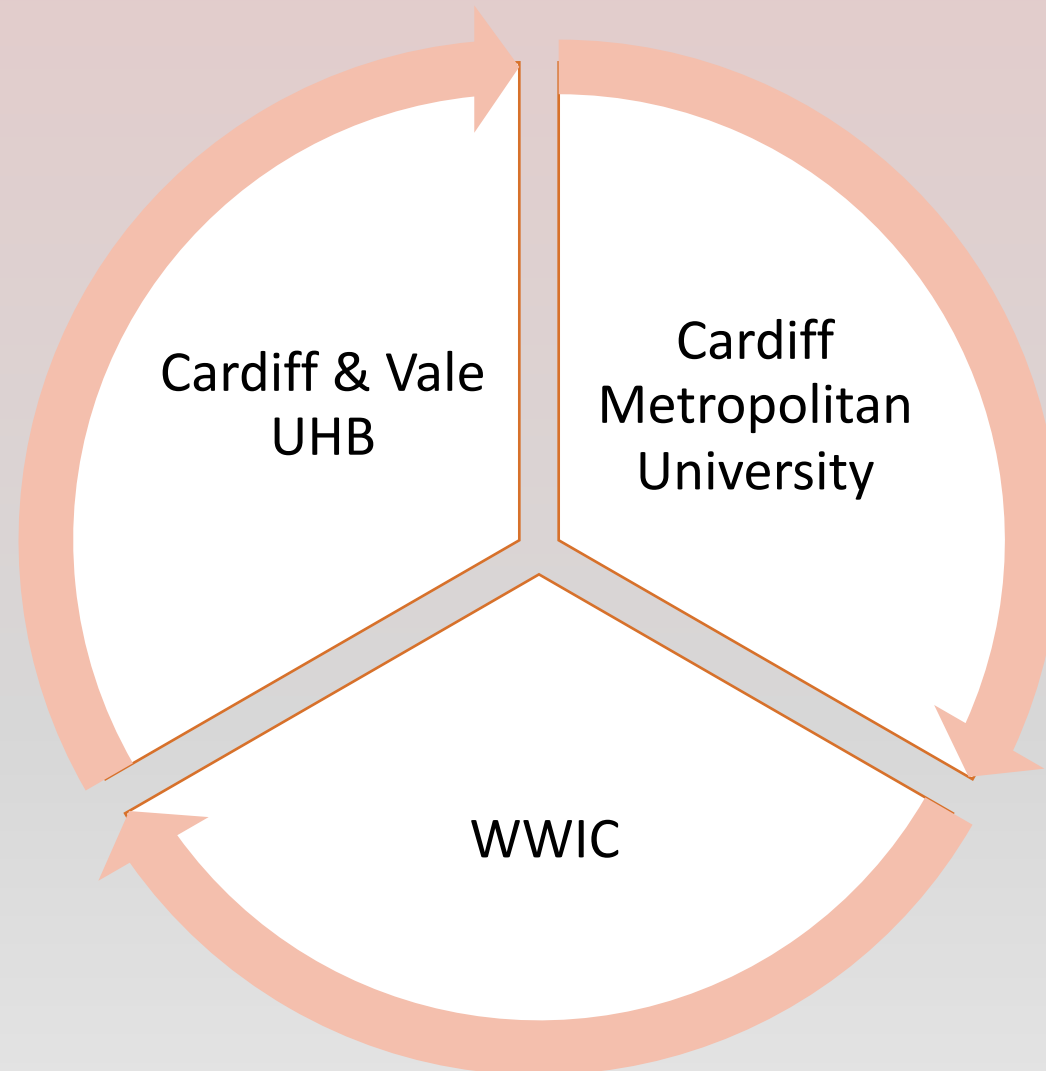
Monthly Alumni

2 hourly sessions repeated three times during the day to accommodate geographical time zones

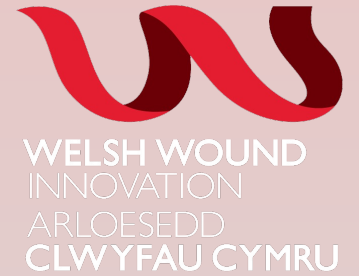
